

Warning about the use of Cookie-files:

Like many other web sites and other services that you use online, our online services (including our websites, mobile sites and applications) use cookie-files.

Cookies are small text files automatically stored in the browser on your device when you visit a website or mobile site, or use an application.

We do not use the cookie-files that access to any information stored on your hard drive, damage your device or expose it to other dangers.

We use the cookie-files to identify your device when you use our online services and to track and provide you with assistance in navigating through our online services.

Examples of data that may be analyzed using cookie-files are: user name; e-mail address and password; IP-address; type and version of the browser; operating system and platform you use to connect; areas of our online services you viewed or searched for; URL-addresses through which you entered and left our online services; date and time of such actions, and other data that make it possible to fully convey our services to you.

We use the cookie-files in the following cases:

To improve the functionality of our online services and ensure the efficient delivery of content through these services.

To analyze the performance of our online services in order to improve them.

Third-party companies (such as social networks, ad networks and providers of external services, including web traffic and marketing analysis services, specified above) can also set through our online services the cookie-files that we do not control.

Some of the cookie-files installed by our online services are permanent, which means that they are stored on your computer for as long as they expire or you delete them. Our regular cookie-files have relatively short duration, because we use them mainly in order help you to avoid repeating the same action on our online resources in a short period of time. However, the analytical cookie-files installed by our online services last longer, as they, for example, help us to recognize you when you return to our websites.

HOW TO CONTROL COOKIE-FILES AND REMOVE THEM?

If you do not want cookie-files to collect information, there is a simple procedure in most of the

browsers that allows the cancellation of their work. For more information how to
